Second bet is guaranteed to lose should the first bet win. If the first bet loses a third bet is placed during half time and an adjustment of the second bet may be needed. However, it is not revealed what bets 2 and 3 comprise. The whole strategy with a calculated staking plan guarantees a profit between 9 to 12% per match.

Lay the draw (or "LTD") strategies involve placing a lay bet on the draw. Once the favourite scores a goal, the draw price will rise and you will be able to close out your trade for a profit. Well, by laying a football team to win halftime/ full-time, we are effectively placing four bets. That is, we are backing the opposition and the draw at half-time, and the opposition and the draw at full-time. If the opposition is winning at half-time, our lay bet is successful. If there is a draw at half-time, then our lay bet is successful.

Back the Draw is a set-and-forget football betting system which is quick, easy and highly profitable. We all know that the only way to profit long-term from betting is to find enough value. With so many traders laying the draw these days, the value is often pushed onto the other side of the book and we have started to exploit that by backing the draw instead.

Once again you can place two bets on the same match to gain a profit from this exchange strategy. The starting bet is to lay the draw, meaning that it is required that one team wins the tie. If a team is up ahead two or three goals, in most cases you should be fine.

Some of the most popular football trading techniques are based on this 'time decay'. For example, if a match is 0-0 at 75 minutes, the odds of a draw will be fairly high. As more time passes and no goals are scored, the higher and higher the likelihood of a draw will become.
